Key facts

1. **OTT platforms** that are digitally streamed falls under the domain of Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (**MeitY**).
2. Several OTT platforms such as Netflix, Amazon prime etc.
3. India has **no Regulations**.
4. Not covered under Central Board of Film Certification.
5. In 2018, MeitY asked OTT media services to regulate themselves now wants to regulate itself.
6. Recently during the lockdown, several OTT platforms witnessed a huge jump in their subscription.
7. Currently, **Internet and Mobile Association of India** (Not-for-profit Industry body) announced code for the self-Regulation for OTT platforms.

INFECTIOUS DISEASES ARE MOSTLY ZOOONOTIC:UNEP REPORT

Key facts

1. This report released by United Nations Environment Programme (**UNEP**) and **International Livestock Research Institute** highlighting increasing trend of Zoonotic diseases.
2. Zoonotic diseases passed into the human population from an animal source.
3. **75% of emerging infectious diseases are Zoonotic.**
4. Factors identified for Zoonotic diseases-Demand of Animal protein, Unsustainable farming, exploitation of wildlife, Unsustainable use of natural resources, Travel and Transportaion, changes in food supply chains and climate change crisis.
5. Suggestion-**One health approach**, which unites public health, veterinary and environmental expertise, as the optimal method for preventing as well as responding to Zoonotic disease outbreaks and pandemics.

KUWAIT EXPAT QUOTA BILL

Key facts

1. Kuwait Introduced a **quota system** for employing foreigners in Kuwait to balance the population proportion of Kuwaitis and expats.
2. Indian expatriate community, which is largest expat group in Kuwait **should not exceed 15%** of the national population.
3. It will **reduce the Indian presence in Kuwait by 7-8 lakhs** and impact India's remittance economy.
